## Benefits of Membership of the Chamber

Membership in the Chamber of Advocates Malta is open to all warranted Maltese lawyers, as well as lawyers from European Union member countries who are duly registered with the Ministry for Justice.

The annual membership fee is valid for every calendar year, i.e. 01 January until 31 December and is automatically renewed, unless the Chamber is advised in writing to terminate the membership, not later than 30 November of the year of the last paid membership fee.

There are several benefits to becoming a member of the Chamber:

- Professional solidarity;
- Representation by a professional association that seeks to promote the interests of the profession;
- The possibility to consult the Chamber on professional ethics issues;
- The use of the premises administered by the Chamber of Advocates and facilities at the said premises, including a designated Business Centre, use of computers, as well as printing and photocopying services and a multi-device charging station;
- Option of a locker (subject to availability and at a fee);
- Loan of togas for use in an emergency;
- Special rates for seminars, conferences and social events organised by the Chamber of Advocates;
